James Walth called the meeting to order at 7:02 p.m. with the Pledge of Allegiance.

A motion was made by Josh Thompson and seconded by David Gray to approve the agenda. All voted in favor of the motion.

A motion was made by Josh Thompson and seconded by David Gray to approve the February 11, 2019 Monthly Board meeting minutes. All voted in favor of the motion. A motion was made by David Gray and seconded by James Walth to approve the meeting minutes of the Audit/Budget meeting held on February 25, 2019.

A motion was made by Josh Thompson and seconded by David Gray to approve the Treasurer's Report subject to audit for the month ending February 28, 2019. All voted in favor of the motion.

A motion was made by Josh Thompson and seconded by David Gray to cash in the last CD at Unity Bank and to transfer it to the savings account in Deerwood Bank. All voted in favor of the motion.

Approval of Claims: A motion was made by Josh Thompson and seconded by David Gray to approve the claims for the month of March totaling \$26,856.86. All voted in favor of the motion.

Roads:

A motion was made by Josh Thompson and seconded by David Gray to approve the resolution for the Township's Snow and Ice Control Policy. All voted in favor of the motion.

Placid Drive Update (safety concerns, signage, etc.): Steve presented a comparison of the recommendations from Crow Wing County, MN DOT and Widseth Smith Nolting for review by the Board. He still feels he does not have enough information to give the Board a solid recommendation. He still needs to do more analysis research. He asked to keep this issue on the April Board meeting agenda.

Road Overseer's Report/Steve Reilly: There are still residents in the Township plowing their driveway snow across into the Township roadways. A public notice was published in the Courier the beginning of winter regarding concerns of obstructing any highway or depositing snow or ice in the Township roadway. The Township needs to maintain safety of the roadways and that the laws are correctly observed according to Minnesota Statute 160.2715. Steve prepared a letter he will be handing out to residents of the Township who are not following the above Minnesota Statute for the Board to review. A motion was made by David Gray and seconded by Josh Thompson to approve the letter and to allow Steve to distribute the letter to repeat offenders of the Statute. All voted in favor of the motion.

FEMA: Steve has not gotten response back from FEMA.

A motion was made by Josh Thompson and seconded by David Gray to enter into the Bituminous Seal Coat Construction Cost Share Agreement with Crow Wing County by having Carol Pundt sign the agreement and mail it off to Crow Wing County. All voted in favor of the motion.

The Board reviewed the Annual meeting agenda for the March 12, 2019 meeting being held at 6:30pm at the Town Hall.
