Discussion centered on having a comprehensive road policy plan that is:

- simple to understand;
- population per mile should be referred to as 3 land owners living adjacent to the road versus 5 households;
- the road needs to be researched, by the requesters, to be properly platted for public use;
- the road would need to be brought up to the standards of the worst Township maintained road;
- road supervisor would do a road assessment to be presented to the Board;
- a formal petition request would need to be presented to the Board;
- subdivision platting would need to meet the most current Crow Wing County's Highway Department Road Construction Specifications;
- the Board reserves the right to accept or reject requests for takeover of any road.

David Gray will draft a policy to be reviewed by the Board at the April 8th Board meeting.
