The purpose of this meeting was to audit the Township financial records for 2024 and to set a preliminary Levy for 2026.

A motion was made by Josh Thompson and seconded by Scott Brix to approve the audit reports (computer reports, bank statements and checks) as reported to the Board by Amy Donovan, Treasurer. All voted in favor of the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

A motion was made by Josh Thompson and seconded by Scott Brix to propose \$725,000 for the 2026 Levy to be presented at the Township annual meeting to be held at the Deerwood Town Hall on March 11, 2025, at 6:30pm. All voted in favor of the motion. Motion passed unanimously. The increase in the levy is due to the increase in costs to run and maintain roads in the Township. Many of the Levy funds for 2026 will be spent on road projects in the Township and fire property protection. Break out of the levy is as follows:
